Nomination Process	Please note: Students can only nominate to attend these trials through their school sports coordinator to their relevant district contact for 13-19 years Softball. Nominations outside of this process will not be accepted. <u>District nominations are due to the Regional Convenor no later than Tuesday 4 February 2025.</u> There are no restrictions to the number of skilled students who can nominate to attend this trial. Schools should only nominate students to the district who have the necessary skills to play at this level.
Eligibility	Students need to be 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18 or 19 years by 31 December 2025 and be currently enrolled in an affiliated Met West School Sport School. Prior to trialling, students must hand completed district forms to the convenor, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> parent consent form principal approval form student details/medical history form No Forms = No Participation at the regional trial
Playing Uniform and Requirements	All students must wear their district or school sports uniform when competing at these trials. Players must provide all necessary playing gear including glove, helmet, bat and catcher's gear for catchers. Individual water bottle, sunscreen and hat. Players are reminded to be sun safety conscious due to lack of shade.
