## **Tennis 13-19 Years Regional Trial**

Trial Date	Thursday, 6 February 2025
Trial Venue	Griffith University Tennis Centre (Mount Gravatt Campus) Sports Road, Mount Gravatt

Trial Times	7.15 am – 4.00 pm (approx.) Players eliminated from both draws may finish as early as 10.00 am. Students will be required to sign out with the Convenor before leaving the venue. Students will be required to return to school under parent/guardian supervision.
Trial Format	One set (first to 6 games, tie break at 5-5), double elimination. Four students of each gender to be invited to the part of the Met West Team

Nomination Process Eligibility	Please note: Students can only nominate to attend these trials through their school Sports Co-ordinator to their relevant District Contact for 13-19 years Tennis.  Nominations must be submitted to the convenor by the 13-19 years District Contact only. Schools nominating directly to the convenor will not be considered.  District nominations are due to the Regional Convenor no later than Monday 25 <sup>th</sup> November 2024.  Districts will have two automatic entries per gender into each respective draw and may nominate six more for consideration by the convenor. As such, district nominations must be submitted in ranking order.  Students who are ranked 3-8 from the district will only be invited to the regional trial by the convenor if they are ranked from 11 <sup>th</sup> to 20 <sup>th</sup> across the whole region for their gender. A maximum* of 20 boys and 20 girls from across the region will be invited to the regional trial by the convenor. Districts must submit the players' Tennis ID and UTR (Universal Tennis Ranking). Districts will be informed of successful trialists.  Students need to be 13 – 19 years by 31 December 2025 and be currently enrolled in an affiliated Met West School Sport School.  Prior to trialling, students must submit completed district forms to the convenor, including  Parent consent form Principal approval form Student details/medical history form  No Forms = No Participation at the regional trial
