Times	Warm-ups can commence at 7.00am in the main pool only. Scheduled events starting at 8.00am District managers must be at the venue by 7.00am and wear a District shirt. A district banner will be set up in your area by the convenor. Please ensure you set up and sit in the allocated areas as per the event map—(Appendix M). There will be a compulsory officials and volunteers meeting at 7.30am in the room under the stairs on pool deck. The meet is expected to be finished by approximately 4.00pm.
Eligibility	Students need to be 10-19 years by 31 December 2024 and be enrolled at an affiliated Metropolitan West School Sport school. Students may compete in their own age group only. Prior to trialling, students must submit the following forms to their District manager. (District managers must collect & store all forms at their school) Student Details/Medical History form Principal Approval form No Forms = No Participation
Format	Please note that some of the events will be swum in a multi-age format. It is important that each competitor nominates their accurate qualifying times, as all events will be seeded based on submitted times. Places for each age group will be determined by times across the heats as no finals will be swum.
Order of Events	Order of Events (Appendix A). Printed programs will not be available. The Order of Events will only be available on the Metropolitan West School Sport website. The Meet Convenor will not be held strictly to the below times. The below times are a guide only. It is expected that competitors will be at the pool for the whole day and at least an hour prior to their events. The organising committee reserves the right to alter the program as required. Event 1 - Start approximately 8.00am Event 18 - Start approximately 8.45am Event 41 - Start approximately 10.45am Event 55 - Start approximately 11.30am Event 75 - Start approximately 11.30am Event 75 - Start approximately 1.15pm Due to the number of events it is unlikely there will be a lunch break.

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Parents & Spectators (NEW)	No admission fee will be charged. This year the venue has instructed that an entry ticket is required for all parents/spectators to enable them to enter the Western Grandstand with their student. Please include a ticket image (Appendix U) & entry requirement information into your District team letter & ask parents/spectators to bring their team letter with them for entry. We will have tickets available in case parents/spectators forget their letter.
Parking	Ample free parking is available at the venue.
Lunch	Canteen will be operating.
Warm Ups	From 7.00am lanes will be hired in the main pool for SUPERVISED WARM-UPS. WARM-UPS AND SWIM-DOWNS in the dive pool can commence at 8.30am providing this does not detract from the running of the meet. All swimmers in the warm-up pool MUST be under the direction of a Manager. If this doesn't occur at the meet, the dive pool will be closed. No bags are allowed on pool deck due to Workplace Health and Safety.
Withdrawals	Nominated swimmers who wish to withdraw from an event on the day of the trial must do so at least one (1) hour before the event. Any swimmer who does not swim a nominated event without completing the withdrawal in time may be denied a start in his/her next nominated event.
Marshalling for Events	 Marshalling shall be conducted in the Marshall room which is located below the main grandstand on pool deck. All competitors must report, when notified to the Marshall room. Students who fail to register by the appropriate time will be withdrawn from the event and will be ineligible for selection in that event. Events being marshalled will be announced & event numbers will be displayed on the pool deck display board.
Medallions	Please note that medallions will not be presented in 2024. This is a trial & medallions are not presented at any other Metropolitan West School Sport regional trial.
First Aid	First Aid personnel from the venue will be in attendance for the duration of the trial.
Disputes	Any protest must be lodged with the Meet Convenor by a District Manager in writing within twenty (20) minute of the completion of the event concerned. A hearing of the Disputes Committee will be convened. The Disputes Committee will be made up of the Metropolitan West Regional School Sport Officer, the Meet Convenor and the Chief Referee.
Rules	All competitors should be aware that this meet is governed by FINA Rules, including the "one start rule", although the Meet Convenor reserves the right to make adjustments as required. All swimwear worn by competitors shall be commercially available products. Swimwear worn by competitors in age group events shall conform to the following design (As per QSS Competition Procedures): • Men's swimwear is limited to one swimsuit that covers at most the

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- body surface from hips to knee. Swimwear must not extend above the waist or below the knees.
- Women's swimwear is limited to one swimsuit that is of "open back" and "open shoulder" designs that may extend down to the knee.
 Swimwear must not extend below the knees.
- Swimwear must not have a zipper or any type of fastening system.
- Suits must be of textile material and must not contain any non-textile material such as polyurethane or neoprene.

	Please be advised that there will be <u>no</u> competition for the following distance events due to the welfare of the swimmers and time constraints. These events will require swimmers to submit a paper nomination – (Appendix K or L). Swimmers who aren't swimming at the trial & only submitting a paper nomination must also complete the QSS Project Consent Form to enable names to be advertised on results/team lists etc.
Events <u>not</u> Conducted at the Trial (Paper Nominations)	10-12 Years: 200m Backstroke, 200m Breaststroke, 200m Butterfly, 400m Freestyle & 400m Individual Medley (Appendix K) 13-19 Years: 200m Backstroke, 200m Breaststroke, 200m Butterfly, 400m Freestyle, 400m Individual Medley, 800m Freestyle & 1500m Freestyle (Appendix L) Students must complete the 10-12 Yrs/13-19 Yrs Distance Events Nomination Form – (Appendix K or L) and email to ann-louise.edwards@qed.qld.gov.au no later than 4pm on Wednesday 7

	Students who are successful in gaining an invitation to compete for MWSS in these distance events will be highlighted and displayed at the Metropolitan West School Sport Regional Swimming Trial at the Sleeman Sports Complex/Brisbane Aquatic Centre on Wednesday 21 February 2024. If your name is highlighted, please report to the Metropolitan West School Sport table on pool deck to receive your paperwork. Schools will also be emailed a list of selected students through their district secretary after the meet.
	District Convenors/Managers are required to send a District Team List
Project Consent	and Consent Summary Form (Appendix J) to the Metropolitan West School Sport Office no later than Wednesday 7 February 2024. The consent summary form identifies students who do & do not have approval to have their names published on results sheets and the Swimming Qld database. It is crucial to the organisation of the event that this form is completed by all Districts by the due date. Information on whether Project Consent approval has been granted will be found on each individual child's QSS Project Consent form (Appendix I) which has been collected & stored by the student's school. School's will submit a consent summary form to the district convenor. See Appendix T for instructions.
Nomination Fee	Each competitor nominating for the trial <u>WILL NOT</u> be required to pay a nomination fee this year, including students who only submit a paper nomination for events not being conducted at the trial.

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Multi-Class athletes who wish to compete at the Metropolitan West School Sport Swimming trial <u>must</u> obtain an official classification or provisional classification and must be selected and nominated by their District. Students who do not have an official or provisional classification will not be permitted to compete at the Metropolitan West School Sport Swimming Trial.

Districts <u>must</u> use the Multi-Class Athlete nomination form – (Appendix O) for ALL Multi-Class nominations and also include nominations in the Meet Manager file. When nominating a Multi-Class athlete in your Meet Manager file please list classification in brackets after their surname i.e. <u>Pike (SB9)</u>. Please refer to the 10-12 Years QSS Multi-Class qualifying times (Appendix P) & the 13-19 Years QSS Multi-Class qualifying times (Appendix Q) when considering an athlete for selection. To compete at the State Championships athletes must participate at our Metropolitan West School Sport Swimming Trial.

Athletes Competing in a Multi Class Event (AWD)

The following events will be available for 10-19 Years athletes competing in a multi class event:

50m Freestyle, 50m Breastroke, 50m Backstroke, 50m Butterfly, 100m Freestyle, 100m Backstroke, 100m Breaststroke, 100m Butterfly, 200m Freestyle & 200m IM.— (Appendix O).

An athlete competing in a multi-class event can now choose to also compete as both an able-bodied athlete in the same event type if they are selected in an able-bodied event by their District.

Before competition, Multi-Class Athletes are required to show proof of their classification by emailing a copy of their classification card. This card is sent to students, by Swimming Qld, once they have been formally classified. Met West Team Invitation

Competitors who fail to finalise their place in the team by <u>4.00pm</u>

<u>Wednesday 6 March 2024 may be withdrawn & replaced by another competitor.</u>

The <u>10-19 Years uniform collection and photograph session</u> will be held at the Mt Gravatt East State School hall, Newnham Rd (C & K carpark entrance) Mt Gravatt East between <u>3.30pm - 5.15pm on</u> Tuesday 12 March 2024.

This is a session for all 10-19 Years athletes invited to be part of the Metropolitan West School Sport Swimming team. Due to strict nomination timelines, full payment must be made through the online portal and forms must be returned by Wednesday 6 March 2024. Competitors who do not provide full payment and forms (met.west@qed.gld.gov.au) by the due date will be automatically

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withdrawn from the Met West School Sport team and replaced with another competitor. Forms & payments cannot be returned at the uniform collection & photograph sessions.

Absent Application for Exemption

Students wishing to be considered for an invitation into the Metropolitan West School Sport Swimming Team, but are unable to compete at the Metropolitan West Regional Trials due to injury or illness, participation in a higher level of competition in that sport, QSS Regional/State team in a different sport or bereavement or compassionate reasons **MUST SUBMIT** a written request on the Absent Application for Exemption Form. (Appendix G)

These students must initially be a member of their respective 2024 District team to warrant consideration for selection in the Metropolitan West School Sport Swimming team. The Absent Application for Exemption Form & necessary paperwork (medical certificate/2024 district results/Principal & parent signatures) must be received by the Regional Convenor by 8.00am on the day of the event. Student submitting a request for an Absentee Application for Exemption form cannot compete at the trial. The student must place all events they wish to be considered for on the Absentee Application for Exemption Form.

Metropolitan West School Sport will consider such applications and advise in due course if the student is to be invited to be a part of the Metropolitan West School Sport SwimmingTeam. The decision by Metropolitan West School Sport is final and is not subject to appeal.

Private Coaches

Private coaches wanting to gain access to pool deck will need to complete the Metropolitan West School Sport Blue Card and Coaching Qualification Register. Please find the survey via the below link/QR Code:

by Friday 16 February 2024. Coaches will need to show photo ID & sign for a Coach's pass & wrist band at the Metropolitan West School Sport table on pool deck at the trial. This information should be placed in your District Team information pack & made available to all students invited into a District Team.

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<u>10–12 years</u>: Tuesday 26 – Thursday 28 March 2024 at the Sleeman Sports Complex in Chandler hosted by the QSS Swimming Committee. Metropolitan West School Sport may nominate the following:

- (2) automatic swimmers who have met the MWSS Qualifying time in all 50m, 100m, 200m events. A further 3 nominations (max. 5) per event who must all equal or be faster than the QSS Qualifying Time.
- In all 400m events, a maximum of (2) swimmers who must both equal or be faster than the QSS Qualifying Time.
- A region will be allowed to exceed the number of automatic & extra nominations in any 50m, 100m & 200m events if they have equalled or swum faster than the QSS EXTRA Qualifying Time.

State Championships

<u>13–19 years</u>: Saturday 23 – Monday 25 March 2024 at the Sleeman Sports Complex in Chandler hosted by the QSS Swimming Committee. Metropolitan West School Sport may nominate the following:

- In all 50m Freestyle events, a maximum of four (4) swimmers.
- In all 800m and 1500m Freestyle events, a maximum of one (1) swimmer.
- In all other individual events a maximum of two (2) swimmers in EACH INDIVIDUAL AGE GROUP.
- In all relay events a maximum of one (1) team.
- Students are to compete in no more than nine (9) individual events.
- A region will be allowed to exceed the number of automatic nominations in any event if they have equalled or swum faster than the QSS Qualifying Time.



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
